

A few days ago I was in Celestynow. This is a small town, in the centre of Poland. I was there because there is a shelter for homeless animals there. In my school, we gathered a lot of dog's food(e.g 13 sacks of grit), some blankets and some bowls. We've collected some money, too. These things were given to the animals in this shelter.

I went there with Mrs. Karwowska and some friends from school. The animals that live in Celestynow shelter are clean, they aren't hungry or thirsty but they aren't as happy as they would be in their houses.

Before this trip, when I thought about an animals' shelter I imagined a dirty place with noisy, wild dogs and cats, but now I can see that I was wrong.

This shelter is friendly for animals and their visitors, but the dogs and cats from Celestynow need our help because now there are living 400 dogs and some other animals. One month of these pets' life costs about 65 000 Polish zlotys.
